## Community Regathering During COVID-19 Effective **Sunday March 7<sup>th</sup>, 2021**

Grace & St. Peter's is now **OPEN** for in-person worship!

Please join us for a single Sung Mass, **Sundays at 10:00 AM.**

We will continue to live-stream this, and all other services, on Facebook Live.

If you join us for Mass, please abide by the following policies for everyone's safety:

- You must wear a mask inside the building, except when receiving communion.
- You must sit a minimum of six feet away from others (unless you are part of the same household). This generally means there should be an empty pew between you and the person in front of/behind you.
- Please take a squirt of hand sanitizer (which will be by the door) upon entering and before receiving Communion. Please receive the host on your palm at this time.
- Please take a bulletin off the table near the entrance and drop your offering in the plate (which will not be passed).
- Reservations are not necessary at this time, but recording everyone's presence is. With masks on, it is very hard to know who's who. Please help the ushers record your name by telling them who you are as you enter the building.
- There is no congregational singing allowed at this time. The choir will sing on the congregation's behalf.
- Communion will be in one kind only, and will be distributed not at the rail, but standing up in the front of the nave. I will wear a mask during distribution and will use sanitizer on my hands immediately prior to distribution.
- We are asked not to linger inside the building after Mass, and gatherings after Mass – such as reception lines and Coffee Hour – remain suspended.
